Since then, he has organised the current student body to help plow Dalee’s land so that he can plant vegetables for his consumption and just recently brought the students to help build a “buttermilk snail” farm to raise snails to sell to hotels nearby to make escargot on their menu. This will help Dalee to provide for his family since his disability (stroke). The snails can sell for \$100 USD per kilogram to 4 star hotels nearby. It’s a wonderful thing to see Somole maturing in his faith and living out the teachings of the Bible and being a great example to the new students of E412. Please continue to pray for him and brother Dalee to stay faithful and dependant upon God for all things spiritual and physical. Amen.

E412 program continues to flourish and transform lives who go through our program by the grace of God. We recently added two more students from Ratanakiri province (Sony and Joy) and our facility is up to max capacity again at 29 people living together under one roof. Naturally, utility and food costs have increased over our budget. Monthly operation costs is around \$2500 per month and our current work fund is only \$1700. I've had to use my personal support to offset the costs and keep us afloat the past couple of months but will be unable to keep it going because my children's school fee is coming up next month and to be honest, I don't know if I'll have enough money to pay Kate and Javan's school fee (\$2400) but I'm living on faith that God will provide, not only for my children's education but for E412's monthly budget as well. May God work on your hearts as you read this report and stir you up to good works to provide for His faithful work overseas and a brother's personal needs.
