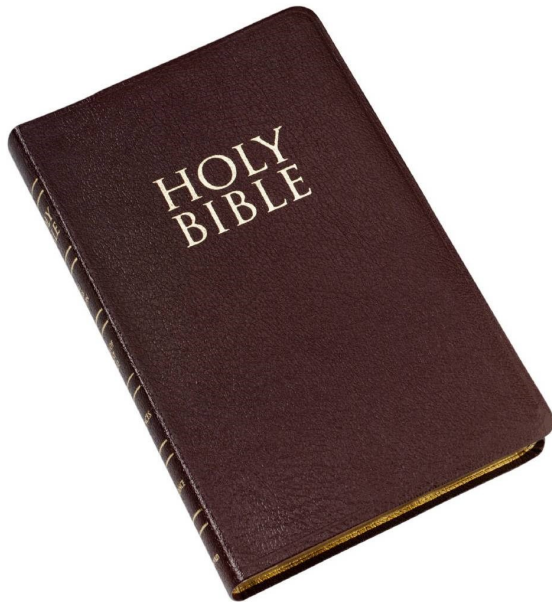


## India

Phanat Ouch is a graduate of the Southwest School of Bible Studies in Austin, Texas. He has been in Cambodia for 17 years. He serves the community in Battambang and other churches of Christ in Siem Reap as well as Phnom Penh.

They have started a new radio ministry and it has resulted in several new additions to the church. He hosted and organized the Asian Mission Forum in Siem Reap for the first time and it was a great success! He was able to spend the last 3 months of his father's life taking care of him and was able to give the eulogy at his funeral. He took his mom to Cambodia to spend quality time with her and to help her through this difficult time. They announced that

Missions is a very important part of our work in the church. We focus a lot of attention of our foreign missions, but we have a great need here in the United States and our own cities.

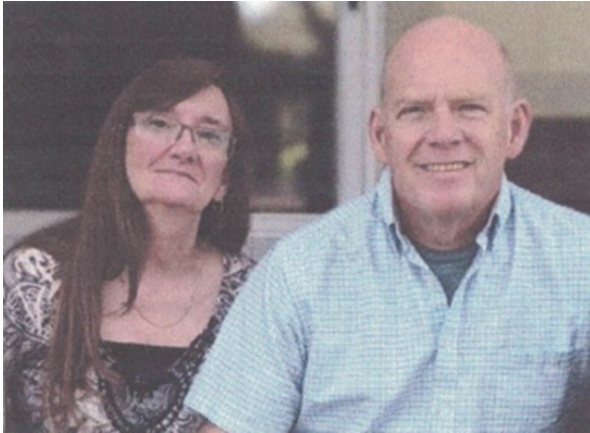
North Main currently has two congregations in Wisconsin that we support.

The men had their annual Men’s Retreat, and they had 23 in attendance this year.

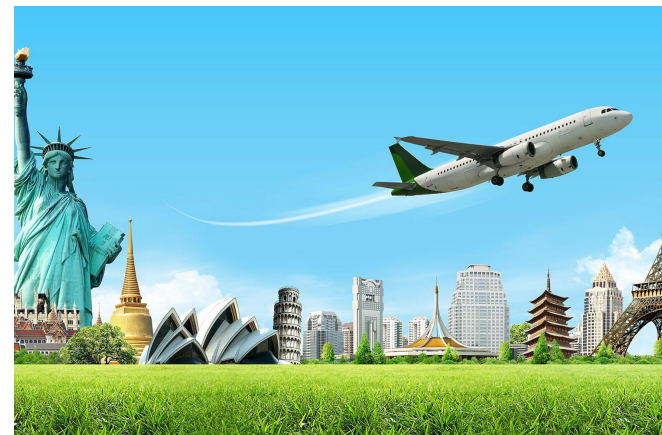
Even though they have no children at their congregation, they held a VBS for grandchildren and those in the community and had 36 in attendance. They were quite pleased with the turnout.
